Fire & Safety: We work to maintain a safe environment in the co-op and coordinate fire inspections. Social: We host many fun events such as our famous barbeques & Pot Luck, Games Night, Halloween, and look after the renting of the common room for personal member parties. We also have a Kids Social Committee. Finance: We make sure that everyone has current house and car insurance, as well as looking after the financial issues of the Co-op.
